Over the past week, we have witnessed unprecedented events unfold, and it is safe to say that we are in uncharted territory. Behind the scenes there have been ongoing discussions, planning, and decision-making related to mitigating the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19). Today, an emergency meeting of the Milltown Public Library Board was held and the decision to close the Library was made. We did not make this decision lightly, but the health and safety of our patrons is a priority.

Therefore, the Milltown Public Library will close at 5 PM on Thursday, March 19, 2020 and will remain closed until further notice, but at least through April 6, 2020.

Courier service and WISCAT requests are suspended .at least through April 5. All due dates on material checked out has been changed to April 6. Patrons can hold onto material until April 6. Holds can be placed as usual on the MORE system and will be filled when normal operations resume.
